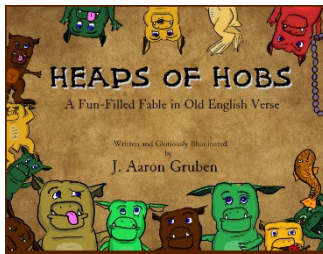


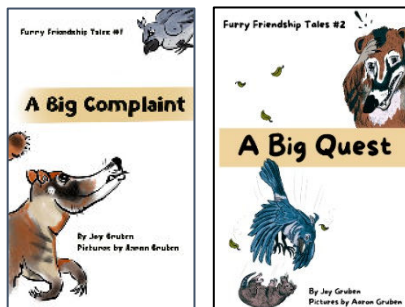
Children's Picture Book

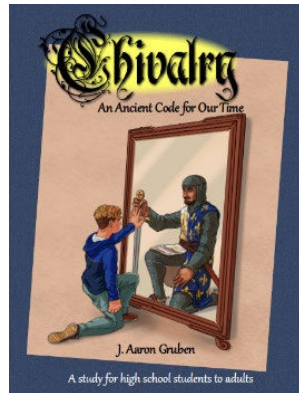

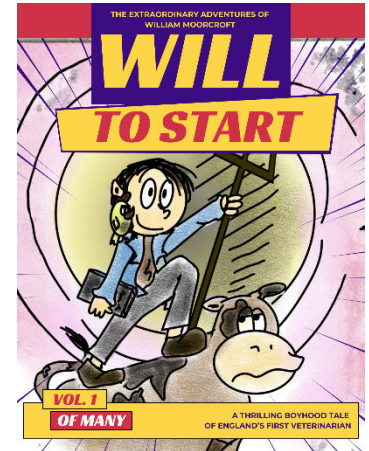

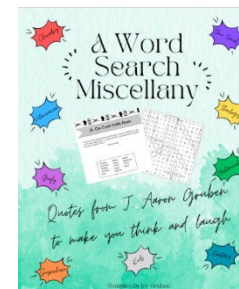
Comic Book

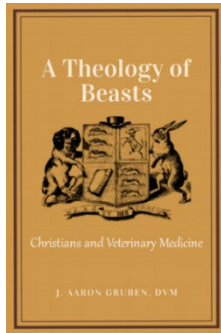

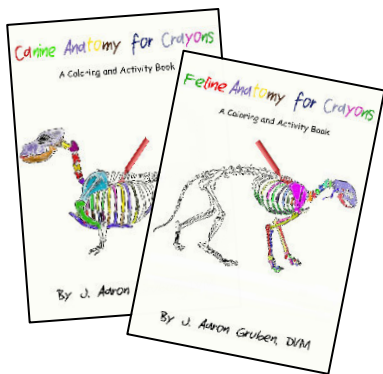
Veterinary

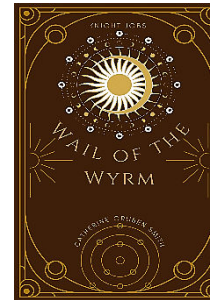

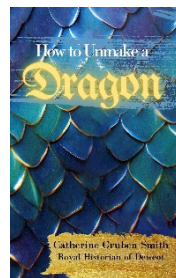

These faery tales are thrilling and chivalrous! *Middle Grade.*

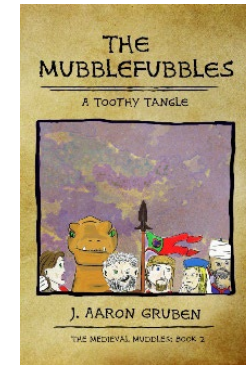
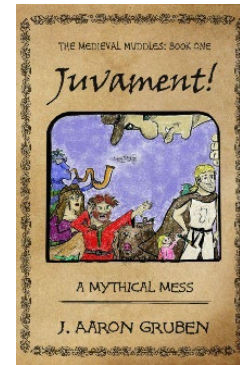

Historical Time Travel

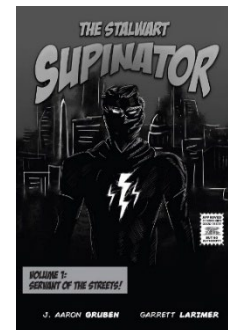
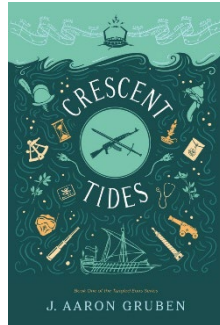
The Tangled Eons are adventures with a time traveling veterinarian – can be read as stand-alone stories. *Teen to adult.*

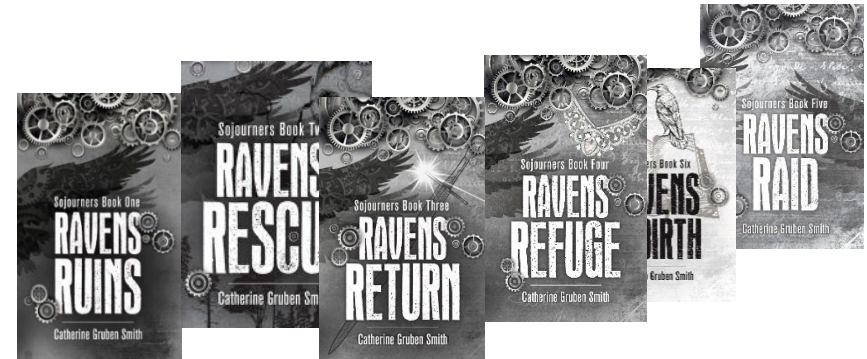

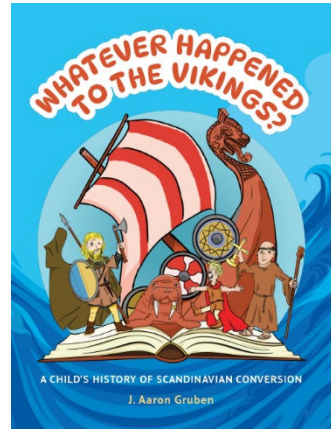
Viking Nonfiction

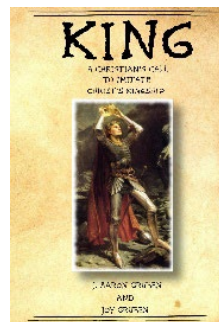
Viking School Study

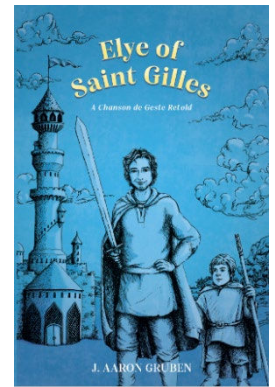


Middle Grade Historical Fiction

Mishaps in Miklagard follows the wild capers of Brom Belcher, a 12-year-old scholar and explorer! His epic journey East to Miklagard (Constantinople) in the 13th century brings him face-to-face with Vikings, befuddling mysteries, and the important question of Who he should live for. This tale in the Medieval Muddles world feels like GA Henty crossed with J. Aaron Gruben goofiness, and includes full-color illustrations and infographics.



Elye of Saint Gilles: A Chanson de Geste Retold. Young Elye is whisked from his home mere hours after becoming a knight. The Saracen king who kidnapped him soon regrets it, as Elye joins forces with a dwarven outcast, a feisty princess, and a haughty horse! This epic tale was a poem originally sung by 13th century troubadours to entertain nobles and teach chivalry, now rewritten for young readers in a whimsical yet edifying style, with original characters and plot intact. It includes original songs and historical appendices!



Logan the Wanderer. This short story in the Tangled Eons world follows 12-year-old Logan as he accidentally travels to 11th century England to be challenged by a Viking king. He navigates an ancient and unfamiliar world filled with knights and priests, sharks and sheep, princesses and secret hallways, wombats and fist bumps!
